It especially means caring for the environment without compromising our commitment to beauty.

SUSTAINABILITY

More than just a passing fad, sustainability is a continuously evolving concept for us. Much of what we have done so far and of what we shall do in future is and must continue to be sustainable. Working towards the year 2030 as our target, we are gradually, year by year, must achieve results compatible with the availability of materials and use technologies that allow them to be achieved. There is no other way. Our commitment to sustainability is the result of a thorough analysis of available resources and the time left for us to use them. Our compliance with objectives is verified from the design phase of every new

product. In short, we are concentrating all the ideas that make up the Kartell philosophy into a single project aimed at promoting sustainability. And we are starting with the materials we use. We now use recycled material derived from pure industrial waste to ensure a perfect finish, wood from certified forests worked into 3D shapes in a special industrial process that uses only the bare minimum of raw material, bio materials derived from agricultural waste and the new, transparent, green polycarbonate 2.0 derived from paper and cellulose waste. Kartell sustainability is also embodied in meaningful attention to previ-

ously overlooked details with a view to achieving, by 2030, all the UN Sustainable Development Goals relevant to us as a company. We have started with daily actions like eliminating single-use plastic and recycling plastics to produce articles like carpets, which we already make using yarn derived from plastic bottles. We also carefully manage the large green park that surrounds our offices and serves as a valuable lung in our fight against emissions. Even the packaging that protects our products contains recycled and recyclable material and benefits the whole supply chain. We want to be a model for the Circular Economy.

DESIGN

Being driven by design helps us express our creativity in different ways, dialogue with creatives and develop projects that are ahead of their time and that transcend passing fashions. We are determined to look to the long term and to design and produce objects that will not suffer from the passage of time. This can only happen if design is original – the expression of a spontaneous idea rather than a response to an external input. It must be the fruit of a free creative process that starts with dia-

logue within our company and gradually transforms a concept into a product. The secret of a product's success lies upstream from production, in a constant and unrestricted dialogue between producer and designer. In this subtle interplay between two parties, pure creativity is guided by know-how, transformed and honed into a finished object. Everything is achieved through dialectic interaction with the world's top designers – the people who form our team, our creative laboratory, our source of inspira-

tion. For us, there are always two sides to design. This year has seen the appearance of new tables and sofas, but next year could just as easily see the arrival of new chairs or accessories. This year, much of our work has been focused on lighting and fabrics, but we have not abandoned (and never shall abandon) plastic as a material: it is becoming greener than ever and can be moulded into even more amazing shapes with industrial levels of performance.

Simple care is needed for the maintenance of Kartell products to retain the original features of the materials.

PLASTIC MATERIALS

Cleaning. Use a soft damp cloth with soap or a liquid detergent, preferably diluted with water.

The use of the following substances must absolutely be avoided: acetone, trichloroethylene, ethyl alcohol or detergents containing even small quantities of these substances which cause irreparable damage to the plastic of which the products are made.

We recommend always using a damp cloth to prevent plastic surfaces from becoming charged with static electricity which attracts dust. Also avoid abrasive solvents, cleaning powders and creams, steel wool or rough sponge cloths.

Use. Do not drag objects across the plastic surface, even if it has a scratch resistant finish, since sharp objects can damage the plastic just as they would damage wood or metal. Do not place very hot plates or pots directly on the surface, but always use a cloth or trivet.

WOOD

Cleaning. As with plastic surfaces, use a soft damp cloth. Do not use alcohol or other spot-removers. For a deeper cleaning use a little non-abrasive liquid detergent and wipe in the direction of the wood grain. Dry the surface well with a soft cloth. Never use acetone, trichloroethylene or ammonia.

Use. Moisture in wood can cause swelling which is normal in a natural material. Our woods hold up well under normal temperature and humidity conditions. Slight color variations from one piece of wood to another are normal and these tend to disappear with time. Wood can change color over time. To delay this, it is best to avoid placing it in direct sunlight.

METALS

Cleaning. Normal dirt on either painted or plain metallic steel or aluminium surfaces must be removed with soap and water (preferably hot) and neutral liquid detergent; dry with a soft cloth or with a chamois cloth. Never use cleaning powders, abrasive or steel wool pads, which can cause scratching, or liquid detergents that contain chlorine or its derivatives such as bleach or muriatic acid.

Use. Avoid spilling grapefruit juice, cola, salt and coffee on metal surfaces. These can cause indelible stains. To remove black marks on aluminium chair legs, products especially made for steel finishes or non-abrasive car polishes are recommended.

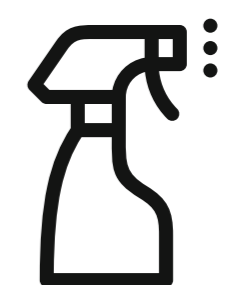
FABRIC COVER

Kartell uses different kinds of covers, for each one you may find the appropriate cleaning and usage instructions within the instruction card enclosed in the packaging.

STONEWARE

Cleaning. For routine surface cleaning, simply use a damp microfibre cloth. For more thorough periodical cleaning, use a neutral liquid detergent with a soft sponge or

microfibre cloth.
Use. Quickly remove any traces of liquids with the potential to stain (e.g. coffee, tea, red wine), plus acids or colouring agents, rinsing the surface with water.
Hot pans can be placed directly on the slabs, however, to preserve the original beauty over time, we recommend using a trivet.
As ceramic knives can damage the surface, we recommend using a chopping board.
Avoid knocks on fragile areas such as edges and corners.

POLYCARBONATE 2.0

Polycarbonate 2.0 is a material, used exclusively by Kartell, which combines a second generation renewable polymer made from cellulose and paper waste with an ISCC (International Sustainability and Carbon Certification) certified process. ISCC was one of the first schemes for the sustainability of products throughout the supply chain in the renewable energy sector to be issued at European level, and it is now one of the most popular and widely recognised. The benefits of polycarbonate, such as superior shock resistant and flame retardant properties, elasticity, excellent mechanical properties and easy recycling, are retained in version 2.0.

CERAMICS

The surfaces of the tables are made of special ceramics processed with low CO2 emissions, using industrial waste and recovering wastewater, resulting in exclusively designed sheets made in Italy. RE-TEXTILE

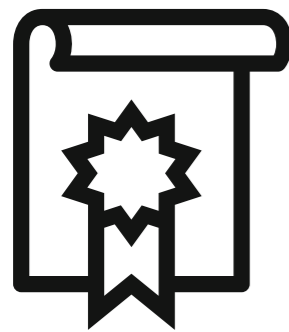

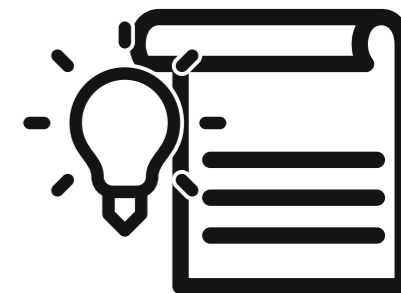

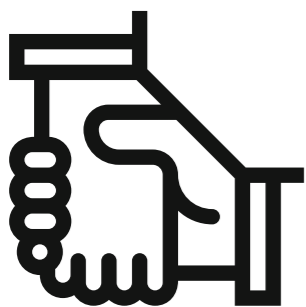

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE



I. SCOPE

1. These General Terms and Conditions govern sales contracts entered into by Kartell S.p.A. ("Kartell") and its clients, professionals that purchase and resell ("Client") the Goods presented in the Kartell catalogue ("Goods"). The General Terms and Conditions of Sale may be waived or modified only through a written agreement between Kartell and the Client.

II. ORDERS

1. Each Product order constitutes an irrevocable offer by the Client. Kartell reserves the right at its sole discretion, to accept, modify or refuse orders at its sole discretion, or to suspend delivery should the Client not provide Kartell with guarantees for the request and not respect the sales guidelines issued by Kartell from time to time.

2. Excluding purchases made for specific purposes agreed in advance with Kartell or in the "contract" channel, the Goods may only be resold retail at the sales point indicated to Kartell.

III. PRICE

1. Unless otherwise agreed, the prices of the Goods indicated in the price list are ex works for deliveries within the European Union, and ex Kartell warehouse for deliveries outside the European Union.

2. The minimum amount of each order for delivery inside Italy is €400.00 (four hundred euros) excluding VAT, and €500.00 (five hundred euros) excluding VAT within the European Union. Should the order not reach this amount, the order may be accepted with a minimum additional charge on the Client invoice of €25.00 (twenty-five euros) in the first case, and €40.00 (forty euros) in the second case as a "partial contribution to expenses".

3. The price applied to the Goods is that in force at the order date. VAT must be added to the prices indicated in the price list (minus any discounts) in accordance with the law.

IV. OWNERSHIP

1. Pursuant to Articles 1523-1526 of the Italian Civil Code, ownership of the Goods will be transferred to the Client only upon full payment of the price. In the event of hire purchase and Client default, Kartell shall retain any instalments already paid by way of compensation, without prejudice to claims for greater damages.

V. PAYMENTS

1. Payment is considered to have been made only when Kartell is in possession of the amount. In the event of payment by cheque or other method, the payment method must

be considered to be accepted subject to payment in due course.

2. However, order payment may not be suspended or delayed due to Client claims or defences regardless of ownership, nor may the Client offset debits and credits with Kartell.

3. In accordance with Article 1186 of the Italian Civil Code, failure to pay or partial payment of any amount owed to Kartell shall automatically place the Client in default with the resulting expiry of the time limit and Kartell's simultaneous right to suspend deliveries, refuse or cancel orders, modify sales conditions and take action to ensure full payment of the credit, in addition to expenses, interests and damages. Late payment will also result in the automatic application (with no prior notice) of late interest at the rate established by Article 5 of Legislative Decree 231/2002.

VI. DELIVERY

1. The delivery date is purely approximate and non-binding, with Kartell being entitled to make partial deliveries.

2. Should delivery be delayed as requested by the Client, Kartell reserves the right to charge monthly warehousing and/or handling expenses equal to 10% (ten percent) of the amount indicated on the invoice, beginning in the month following notice to the Client of the Goods' availability.

3. Any Product order cancellation or rejection at receipt will result in the application of a penalty on the Client of 30% (thirty percent) of the amount indicated on the invoice, without prejudice to claims for greater damages.

4. Should the Goods be shipped outside EU territory, the Client must provide Kartell all documents certifying Product delivery within one (1) month. Should the Client fail to do so, Kartell reserves the right to charge the Client all expenses incurred to complete the sale operation.

5. At delivery, the Client must carefully inspect the quantity and condition of Product packaging. On pain of forfeiture, any obvious defect must be: (i) reported in writing to the shipper at the time of delivery, indicating expressly on the consignment note "conditional acceptance", and (ii) promptly reported in writing to Kartell within 48 (forty-eight) hours of delivery, in compliance with the instructions below.

6. Any returns must be approved in writing in advance by Kartell: unauthorised returns will be returned to the sender along with delivery charges.

VII. GUARANTEE AND CLAIMS

1. The legal guarantee for the Goods begins, as per Article 1495 of the Italian Civil Code, on the date of acceptance of Product delivery by the Client or its representatives.

2. Any claim regarding the Goods (excluding those identified at the time of receipt and regarding shipping) must be made in writing to Kartell **within 8 (eight) days** of the discovery, and in any case **within 12 (twelve) months** of Product delivery acceptance by the Client or its representatives in compliance with the following procedure: (Par. 6. Claims)

3. With reference to the Consumer Code, Legislative Decree 206 of 6 September 2005, Articles 131 and 132, the Client loses and forfeits any right of recourse against Kartell if it does not notify Kartell in writing of an

end-customer claim within 8 (eight) days of receipt of the end customer's complaint using the procedure described above.

4. Kartell shall not be liable for damages caused by improper use, tampering, normal wear or failure to respect the assembly and maintenance instructions included in the product card, or component modifications or replacements with others not in accordance with the original specifications.

5. In any case, Kartell's liability is limited to the value of the defective goods: Therefore, Kartell may not be held liable, among other things, for expenses sustained by the Client or end customer or for any other damage claimed (direct or indirect).

6. **The bulbs contained in the packaging of each lamp are supplied by Kartell as a courtesy in order to provide the best service to our customers.** However, since these accessories are not directly manufactured by Kartell but supplied by external suppliers, Kartell does not guarantee their correct function. In case of bulb fault or failure, it is the customer's responsibility to replace the bulb, in compliance with the technical information in the catalogue, in the dedicated section, or in the instruction booklet enclosed with the product, to which reference is made in full, and for which Kartell assumes no liability.

VIII. COMPETENT COURT

1. Any disputes arising directly or indirectly from the contractual relationship are the exclusive competence of the Milan court.

2. Applicable law is substantially Italian (excluding any application of foreign laws).

CLAIMS FOR SHIPPING DAMAGE

Should one of the following situations be noted at the time of Product delivery

- merchandise missing with respect to accompanying document
- merchandise different with respect to accompanying document
- Damaged packaging, highlighted by the relevant impact indicator where it is affixed to the packaging;

the Client must

- write reservations on the consignment note (either on the carrier's copy or on the recipient's copy). Written reservations must be detailed, as general reservations are not sufficient to allow proper processing of the claim
- Complete the reporting form (Transport claim form) in full: the form (facsimile shown below) is available from Kartell's regional agent, or Kartell's Sales Office at transport@kartell.it;
- Send a copy of the consignment note and the reporting form within 48 (forty-eight) hours of Product receipt.

CLAIMS FOR PRODUCT NON-CONFORMITY

To notify Kartell of a claim in the event of Product non-compliance, send the following documents to the Kartell Customer Care Office at quality@kartell.it:

- The product non-compliance form (Generic claim form) completed in full: the form (facsimile shown below) is available from the Kartell Customer Care Office, at the e-mail address above, or from Kartell's regional agent;
- Photographs showing the non-compliance (at least one photo per non-compliant Product)

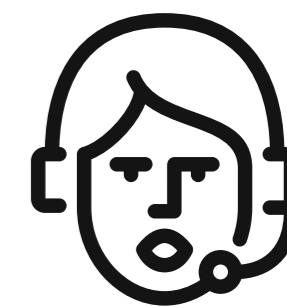
If the complaint concerns a **new product** - just received by the customer or just delivered by the customer to the end customer - you must also send images of the relative packaging, supplying a full view and close up of the double label (production and shipping), as shown below.

You should keep hold of the Quality Control slip found inside the Product information, because it contains information which may be required by the Kartell Customer Care Department to make any required checks on production batches potentially affected by non-compliance. **After sending the documentation indicated in the above paragraphs, we recommend you keep the original product packaging.**

Only reports sent to the aforementioned addresses along with all the required elements will be taken into consideration by Kartell. In the absence of any or all of the required documentation and/or the original packaging, or in

the case of failure to follow the procedure set out above, Kartell will be unable to follow up your report.

Kartell cannot be held liable for any damage, defects or faults caused to the products or resulting in any way from and/or connected with transport or deliveries not carried out directly by Kartell through its agents or carriers. Kartell strongly recommends the use of transport companies with proven experience, which guarantee a high level of service.

If it is possible to use the WebUP system, the complaint can be registered in the system using the same procedure.
